

Syllabus Summary to the discipline "Introduction to specialty" for the specialty 33.05.01 – Pharmacy

The objectives of the course “Introduction to specialty” is to make students aware of the details of the specialty chosen, its curriculum, role and place and significance of particular subjects while mastering a specialty, basic requirements to the quality of training; to give insight into future professional activities in the pharmacies and other medical and pharmaceutical organizations and enterprises involved in drug provision for the population.

The syllabus was developed in accordance with the requirements of the Federal State Educational Standard of Higher Education, approved by order of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation dated March 27, 2018 No. 219, for the specialty 33.05.01 - Pharmacy.

The volume of the syllabus of the course “Introduction to specialty” is 108 hours (3 credits), of which 6×2 hours of lectures (12 hours in total), practical classroom activities 16×3 hours (48 hours in total), students’ individual work (45 hours), credit tests (3 hours).

The process of studying the discipline is aimed at providing insight into pharmacy, other basic disciplines and their concepts, and the historical roots of provisional activities. The questions are studied predominantly on the basis of ideas about pharmaceutical activity and acquaintance with organizations, and only a few, fundamental skills at the level of knowledge. It is based on the statutes of the law on the regulation of pharmaceutical activity: the Federal Law "On the Circulation of Medicines", "State Pharmacopoeia", ECE documents, regulatory documents, etc. Particular attention is paid to the formation of students' social orientation and importance of state regulation of the pharmaceutical market.

The student gains basic knowledge and ideas about state legal acts in the field of medicine and pharmacy, the role of pharmacy in organizing the production of medicines, about electronic information systems used in pharmacies, they learn to carry out activities in emergency antiepidemic situations, to assess the feasibility of population protection activities in emergency situations, to work properly with the cash register equipment.
